

The Inside Scoop

Classroom lessons are one of the service methods your school counselor uses to present information to students. During Quarter 1 each grade level has received the following information:

- Seniors: Leadership Seminar during Access Period
- Juniors: Graduation requirements, transcripts, and ACT
- Sophomores: Graduation requirements, transcripts, and the RIASEC assessment
- Freshmen: Graduation requirements and introduction to high school
