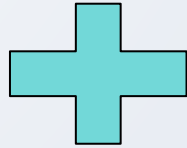

- Readiness (Earn 2 readiness seals)

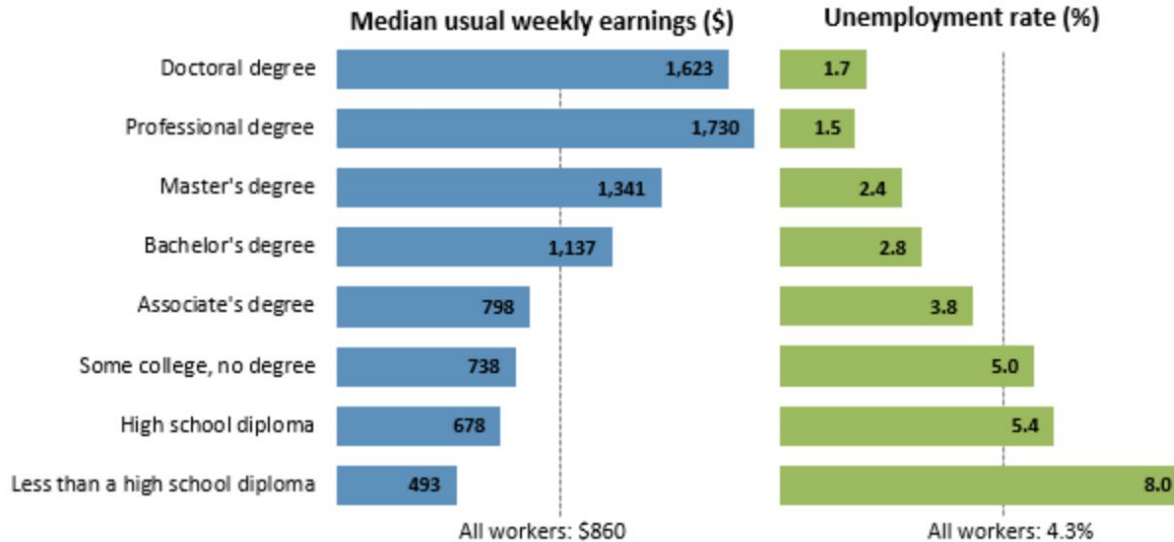
